DURING THIS HOLIDAY, THE INDIAN FLAG IS HOISTED ON HOUSES AND OFFICES ALL OVER THE COUNTRY. THIS IS DONE AS A SYMBOL OF PRIDE FOR THE CREATION OF THE COUNTRY AND SHOWS PATRIOTISM AND NATIONAL IDENTITY INDIFFERENT OF CASTE OR ECONOMIC STATUS. ON THIS DAY INDIANS TYPICALLY WATCH THE PRIME MINISTER'S SPEECH AND A BIG FLAG IS RAISED IN THE EMBLEMATIC RED FORT IN DELHI.

IT IS ALSO USUAL FOR MANY INDIANS TO DRESS UP, DECORATE THEIR CARS AND PAINT THEIR FACES WITH THE COLORS OF THE INDIAN FLAG. Another tradition on this day is kite flying. Hundreds of People Go out and fly their kites high up in the Sky as a symbol of India's Freedom.
